

Technology: A Day in the Life - Scenario 2

Head Start director Tess Nology prepares for the School Readiness Committee meeting this afternoon. These meetings are always well-attended by internal staff and community partners. She reviews the materials distributed in advance to participants, including child outcomes data for the last quarter and a school readiness goals progress report.
