

CURRICULUM MODIFICATIONS:

A small change to ongoing classroom activities or materials to increase a child's participation

Activity simplification is one of the eight types of curriculum modifications.

ACTIVITY SIMPLIFICATION

Simplify a complicated task by breaking it down into smaller parts or reducing the number of steps.

CHANGE THE STEPS



1. **Teacher** opens bag.



2. **Child** takes bread out of bag.



3. **Child** puts bread in toaster.



4. **Teacher** closes bag.



5. **Teacher** takes toast out of toaster.



6. **Child** spreads butter on toast.

REDUCE THE NUMBER OF STEPS



1. **Child** opens bag.



2. **Child** takes bread out of bag.



3. **Teacher** puts bread in toaster.



4. **Teacher** closes bag.

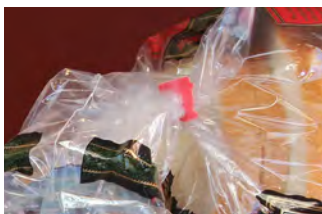


5. **Teacher** takes toast out of toaster.
