- 4. Resources to support kindergarten transition efforts.

Starting elementary school is one of the most critical transitions children face. For children, it means adjusting to a new setting, learning a new set of rules and behaviors, and getting to know new peer groups and teachers. For parents, it means learning about and adjusting to school district policies, meeting and communicating with teachers, and sharing key information about their children.

The management of kindergarten transitions has the potential to impact children's early and later school success. At the heart of making this transition successful is the ability for early learning settings, elementary schools, and families to work closely together at aligning experiences, providing information, and building relationships. Fostering alignment across settings better supports children and families. We hope you can attend so that we can share transition information with you as well as learn from your current practices!
