







# **Important COVID-19 Risk Reduction Reminders**

- As we get ready to move into the program year, **COVID-19 risk reduction strategies remain critical to protect all people**, especially children and staff who are not fully vaccinated, and especially in areas of moderate-tohigh community transmission levels.
- Vaccination is the safest way to protect individuals and the people they live and work with from getting COVID-19. Vaccines are working to prevent severe illness, hospitalization, and death.
- On Monday August 23, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration approved the first COVID-19 vaccine – the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine.
- Programs should plan to implement layered risk reduction strategies that include vaccines, masking, health screenings, physical distancing, ventilation, hand hygiene, and cleaning.
