- Reflect on own perspective








## **Reflect on Conversations and Perspectives**



- Did I begin the conversation from a strengths-based perspective? Have I invited, listened to, and tried to understand family perspectives?
- How have I listened to and used family perspectives and to further the conversation?
- Have I shown the family that I value their perspective and expertise of their child?
- Have I reflected on my own perspectives on my concerns about this child's development or behavior?
