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## LMS Workgroup – Terms of Use

**A Guide for LMS Administrators**

The State LMS Administrators Workgroup is a private, member only online space<sup>1</sup> for Originators<sup>2</sup> and Users<sup>3</sup> to share professional development (PD) modules and trainings for early childhood providers. It is anticipated that both Originators and Users will upload and download courses in good faith, as these materials are not endorsed or owned by NCECDL or the Office of Head Start. To support these efforts, this guide proposes language for Originators and Users to consider including in their materials as a sample sharing agreement. This guidance is intended to support state LMS Administrators in sharing materials for early childhood professionals.

**Terms of Use**

Please read the Terms of Use before uploading and downloading materials on MyPeers.

By signing on the line below,

- I acknowledge I have read, understand and agree to comply with the Terms of Use as articulated herein.
- As an Originator, I acknowledge the following related to uploading and sharing my state/organization's LMS materials:
  - I have completed the Modules Matrix for each module.
  - I will upload and appropriately note any copyright and/or legal restrictions of use.
  - I have included information about appropriate use of materials and permissions within the course materials so that Users will know how these materials may be used including guidance about whether and how course materials may be modified.
  - By uploading my state/organization's materials I am making them available for other members to download and use in their respective LMS only.

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### Status of Pennsylvania's PD Registry

- New Pennsylvania registry was implemented in February 2018
- Workforce Data Registry and Learning Management System
- There are currently 67,000 active users  
Expecting up to 200,000 active users with new QRIS standards

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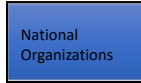
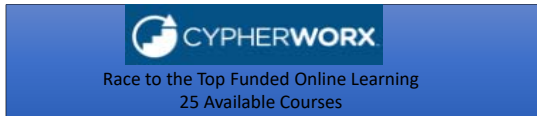
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### E-Learning Courses in Pennsylvania's Registry



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### Courses Created with Race to the Top Funds

- \$750,000 to create 120 hours of online content in 3 years.
- Consultant contracted with PA Key/OCDEL to work with SME
- Identified gaps in Professional Development topics
- SME were PQAS certified and experts in specific content areas
- SME created the content and Knowledge checks
- Cypherworxs created the Instructional Design
- Sent to Consumer Reviewers
- Edited as needed and published



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### Course Completions



- High completion rate because of convenience and ease of technical functionality
- Various topics including Health & Safety
- Courses taken by PQAS applicants (Trainers)
- Spanish version for some courses
