
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



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



























Behavioral Expectations in Advance Let preschool children know what is going to happen next: "We're going to clean up for group time in five minutes so it's a good time to start finishing up whatever you're working on." "First, we will wash hands, then we will sit down for snack." "After you get your coats and shoes on you can look at a book by the door until everyone is ready." "When we come back inside it will be lunchtime then it will be nap time. Let's get our mats set up now so we're ready for rest after lunch."



Show interest in children's experiences and ideas: "I am very curious about your block structure. Can you tell me more about what you're working on?" Match the child's level of energy, volume and emotional expression: "I can see how focused and hard you are all working on this floor puzzle! Keep up the great teamwork!" Share affection and use words that communicate respect: "Thank you so much for helping Amelia put away those books! That was so thoughtful."
